CT SCAN OF THE PELVIS:

INDICATION: LEFT LEG SWELLING

PROCEDURE:

The patient was given diluted Gastrografin orally as well a Gastrografin enema. A total of 50 cc of Omnipaque 300 was given intravenously. Multiple axial images of the pelvis were obtained.

FINDINGS:

Comparison is made to previous examination of January 8, 1999. Again seen is mild asymmetry in the size of the deep femoral veins, left greater than right. In addition, there is low density noted in the left deep femoral vein suggestive of a thrombus. No masses are noted in the pelvis. There is no adenopathy. The bladder is normal. The visualized loops of bowel are unremarkable. The surrounding soft tissues are normal.

IMPRESSION:

 ASYMMETRY IN THE SIZE OF THE DEEP FEMORAL VEINS, LEFT GREATER THAN RIGHT WITH INTRALUMINAL FILLING DEFECT ON THE LEFT SIDE SUGGESTIVE OF A THROMBUS. RECOMMEND CORRELATION WITH AN ULTRASOUND STUDY TO RULE OUT VENOUS THROMBOSIS.
